The Eugene Hotel book group members will meet in the lounge on **Friday, September 30** at **2:30 p.m.** to discuss *thirteen moons* by Charles Frazier. This novel tells the story of an orphan who finds love and acceptance with the Cherokee people after he is sent on a journey through their territory. It is roughly based on a Confederate Army officer who is the only white man to ever serve as an Indian Chief.

The protagonist, Will Cooper, is an elderly man who once served as a frontiersman with the Cherokee Nation. Knowing that he will die soon, he reminisces about the past. As the novel opens, Will receives an unexpected telephone call from Claire. Claire meant everything to him when he was a young man, but he let her slip away and he has regretted it ever since. This may be his last chance to speak with her before he dies.

In October, the book group will discuss a great book to be announced.
