Like many Eugene amenities, the Hotel has its roots in University of Oregon sports. It opened in 1925 when local business leaders decided "it is disgraceful" not to have a classy hotel large enough to accommodate well-heeled out-of-town visitors coming for home games and to host banquets, social, and athletic activities. In 1916, avid sports fan and business leader, Bird Rose, convinced ten local businessmen to invest \$10,000 each (nearly \$300,000 today) to buy land and develop architectural plans for a first-class hotel. Nine years later, funded by local investors, the grand opening was held on June 15, 1925. With much fanfare, it was attended by many prominent business leaders, politicians and other dignitaries from across the state.

For the first 60 of its 100 years, The Eugene Hotel was a premier facility for local events and was known to be an inviting and elegant stopover for those traveling north and south on the then new Pacific Highway 99. During this time, the Hotel catered to locals and visitors, hosting many well-known sports, entertainment and political guests, including:

☐ Bobby Kennedy. Sadly, The Eugene Hotel was the last place where Bobby Kennedy stayed on his way to Los Angeles right before he was assassinated. In 1983, the Hotel was converted to apartments for independent and active adults age 58 and older. The transformation from hotel to an active senior living community was

The goal of the developers, as communicated to the National Historic Registry, was "to recreate the warmth and elegance of the period in which the Hotel enjoyed its greatest success." Currently, with its walls and community spaces filled with murals and Eugene memorabilia that spans the decades along with a diverse community of senior residents, The Eugene Hotel continues her proud legacy as the heart of our downtown.
